Dear Sir:

As Golf Course Superintendent at the Gadsden Country Club for almost 14 years, it is my pleasure to let you know what an important part of my cultural practices the family of Daniels products has become. My first exposure to your products came from a very good friend that at the time sold a competitive line of products.

On August 6 & 7, 2001, we sprayed a split application of pre-emerge to our Crenshaw bent grass greens at a half rate each day with irrigation following as soon as the spray was completed on each green. Over the next week I noticed a continuous decline in the quality of my putting green surface. This decline continued with out explanation over the next few weeks no matter what products were used. On August 28, 2001 my friend that sold the competitive line of products brought me some Daniels 10-3-5 that a superintendent in the Birmingham area had on hand. On August 29, 2001 we sprayed the 10-3-5 product at a rate of 18.8 oz per 1000ft. and over the next three days watched everything hold it's own. On the fourth day it seems things were getting better and maybe even turning around for the good. That trend did continue and things did turn around. On September 11, 2001, a day I will always remember for many different reasons, I received a call while driving down the road that I needed to take a look at a specific web site. On the web site was the answer to all my problems. It was as I had suspected, contaminated pre-emerge.

During the spring of 2003 I started getting called on by Jim Barth who OFFICALLY introduced me to the line of Daniels products. At that time the Daniels products were incorporated into my greens nutrient program with weekly usage. I have found that weekly applications of the 5-0-7 Plus at a rate of 10 oz/1000 ft. along with my granular program has improved my tissue test values. Prior to aerification we use the 10-3-5 at 15 oz per 1000ft. to increase the rate of recovery. These products have truly done everything that Progressive Turf say they will.
